Over 70 countries lost people ... here



A life size metal cast of an individual from each country will make up the figures of this memorial as well as figures of the police, firemen, and other's who perished in this tragedy. There are over 85 figures in the sculpture, fused together, holding each other, supporting each other.

They are situated on a base surfaced with white marble. Nothing will be written on the outside of the base. There is one door.

Inside will be etched in stone (white marble) the names of those who perished. The walls will be cantered out slightly so you feel as if being released When standing inside the memorial. From outside They will feel as if they soar over you.

- Inside view of memorial looking up. It is open to the sky. At night it would be brightly lit inside casting a beam upward.
- The North Tower and South Tower footprints will contain a grid of trees and be a place for nature. They become parks. Their perimeter will be delineated by a walkway of concrete or stone. Solid stone or cement bench "cubes "will dot the perimeter for seating. The trees may exist in pots or the ground level raised with soil to accommodate them.
- The Liberty wall should have words inscribed into it, excerpts from the constitution of this great country. It should also leave room for future amendments. I am not sure exactly which passages or words to use. That is best left to poets and scholars but they should involve:

All people being created equal.

Liberty and justice for all.

The pursuit of freedom and happiness.
